

WHERE WE MEET

The George in Southwark is the last surviving galleried coaching inn in London. Owned by The National Trust, an inn has stood here since the 11th Century, and was the starting point for fast coaches taking pilgrims to Canterbury and Naval Captains to Portsmouth. Shakespeare held plays in the courtyard before the advent of theatres, & Dickens drank coffee in what is now the second bar. The Society of London Ragamuffins hold Tavern Evenings & our Council Meetings at The George. Conveniently situated in a cobbled courtyard off Borough High Street it is a short 3 minute walk from London Bridge rail and Tube Station.
