The Club was founded in 1891 by Neville Campbell and moved to Halkin Street in 1946. The present building was built for Hugh Morrison, a politician and wealthy landowner. Number 9 Halkin Street was the last mansion house of its kind to be built in London.

The minimum degree of Scottishness required of a candidate for membership is at least one Scottish grandparent or to have served, in the opinion of the Committee, "in an important capacity in the public service of Scotland".
